

LINK LIGHT RAIL Construction Update

Update No. 8 in 2006

Beacon Hill Station

Obayashi Corporation, the Beacon Hill construction contractor, continues to build the underground Beacon Hill Station. At approximately 165 feet deep, workers continue to mine the station's south platform and have started to construct the station's north platform. This work occurs around the clock.

BEACON HILL

Concrete batch plant Inside the noise wall, a concrete batch plant was installed near the Lander Street gate. Because of this operation, trucks are exiting the site through the El Centro de la Raza parking lot (which Sound Transit is leasing). Additional noise panels were erected and to minimize dust, a wheel wash will be installed in the parking lot area.

Mount Baker Station Area

East Portal In July, Obayashi began building an earth embankment at the east portal, located south of McClellan Street and west of 26th Avenue. This earth embankment initially will serve as a platform when the tunnel boring machine comes through the Beacon Hill tunnel, and later as a platform for light rail trains entering and exiting the tunnel.

Elevated Trackway The elevated trackway continues to be built in sections between the columns. Falsework is installed on Martin Luther King Jr. Way South along the west end of the pedestrian bridge. This falsework will be extended to the next columns south near Hanford Street. The contractor also is building elevated trackway across 26th Avenue south of McClellan Street. 26th Avenue is temporarily closed while this work occurs.

Traffic flow on MLK Jr. Way Sound Transit and Obayashi are considering different ways to move traffic around construction when the elevated trackway is built near Horton Street. It is possible that vehicles would use different lanes from the current traffic configuration. We will provide more information about traffic flow in this area.

Beacon Hill Tunnel

The tunnel boring machine (TBM) digging the Beacon Hill Tunnel has now advanced over 1700 feet. In July it reached the edge of the Beacon Hill Station. Currently, the machine is stopped until the Beacon Hill Station's south platform is excavated. Then, the TBM will be "walked through" the station and will undergo maintenance. After maintenance is completed, it will go to work digging the southbound tunnel from the Beacon Hill Station to the east portal.

Blue Box Tour: Beacon Hill Station

After the August 28 meeting at the library, Sound Transit and Obayashi will escort interested people inside the Beacon Hill Station (behind the blue wall) to look at the excavation. Space is limited to 20 people, 18 years and older. Please wear long pants and boots. We will provide hard hats, vests, and protective eyewear. You will also need to sign a waiver.
